Grant offers to students for approved applications will be made on the basis of the individual student's enrollment status and Expected Family Contribution (EFC) as calculated from the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) until the initial grant allocation has been exhausted. If you have not already submitted a FAFSA, you may do so now at <https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa>. We will resume our review of student applications and subsequent disbursement of approved grant offers after WCU receives the second disbursement of our allocation from the U.S. Department of Education. The Department of Education has not yet provided an expected disbursement date for our second half of the allocation, but WCU is committed to awarding the funds as soon as we receive them.

By design of this law, the offer of grant funds to students is at the sole discretion of the WCU Financial Aid Student Emergency Grant Committee. Applicants will be notified via email as applications are reviewed. Our selection process gives priority to the students with the highest need but also limits offer amounts to ensure that funds are widely available to as many students as possible. However, not all who apply may receive a grant offer. Once awarded, grant funds will be disbursed according to the refund method you selected on the BankMobile platform. We recommend all students select the direct deposit refund option to ensure fastest delivery of funds. 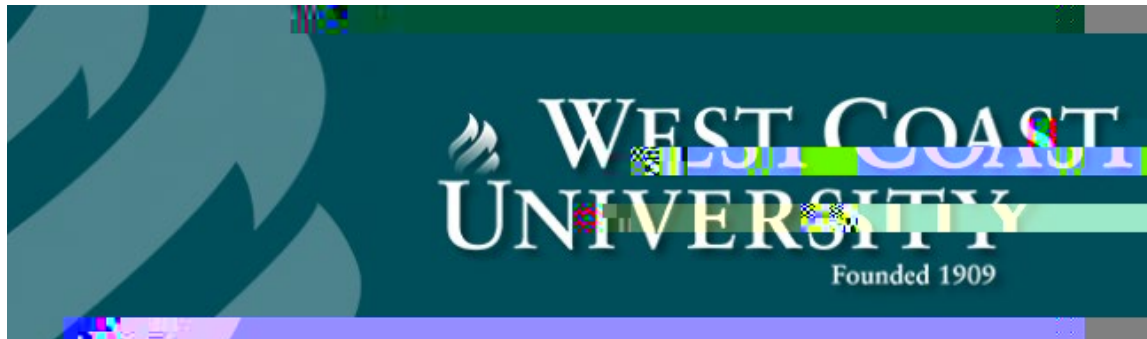

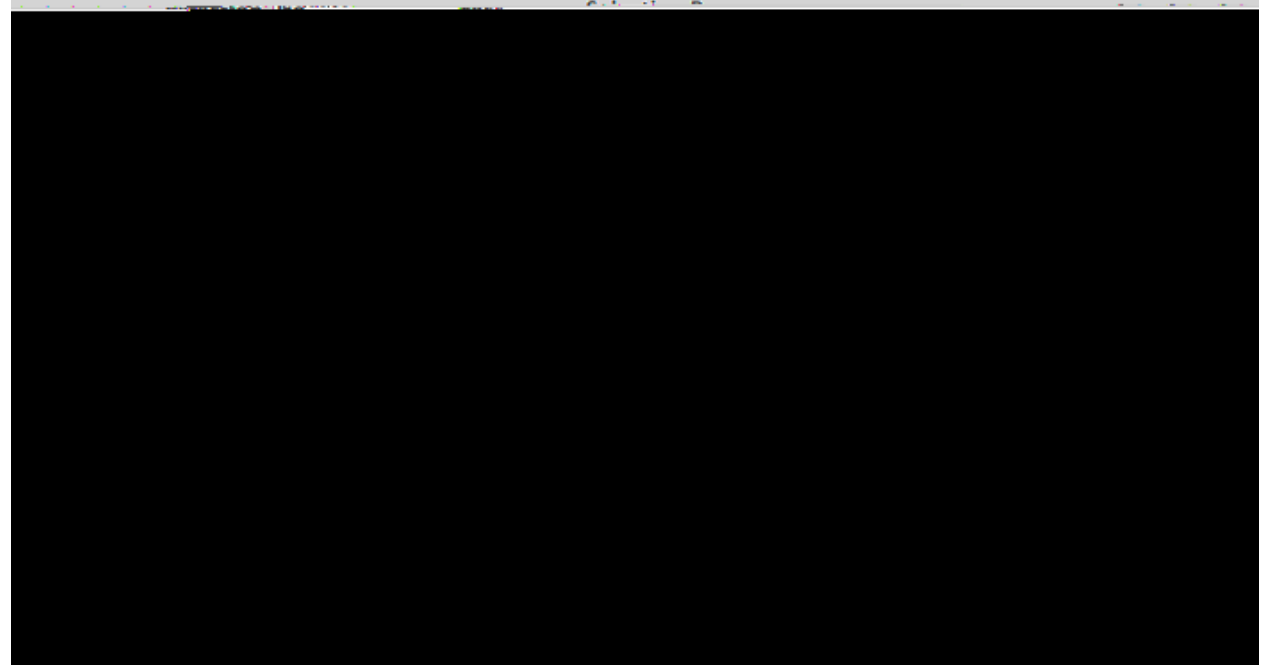

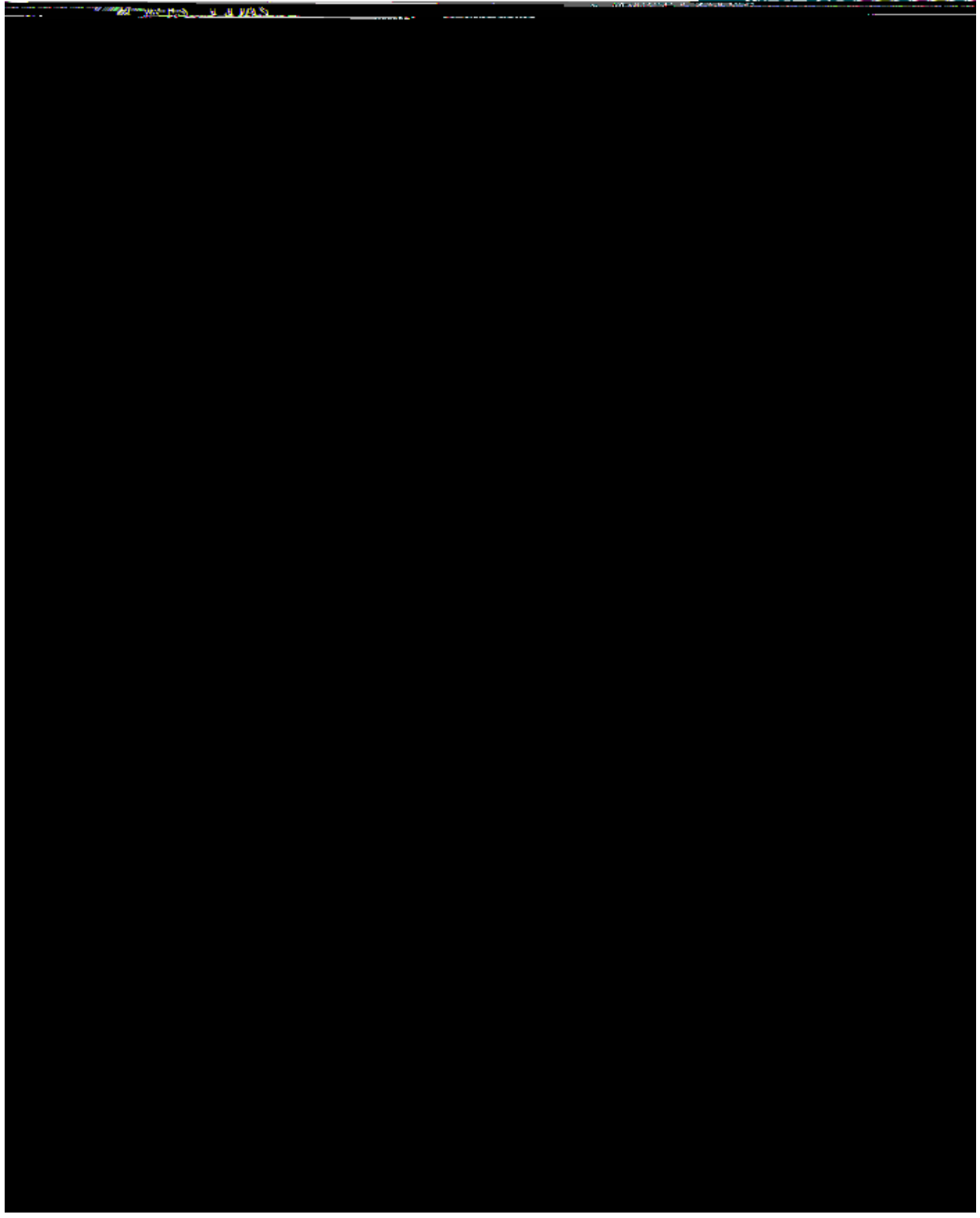
